Riley Dunn & Wilson announce launch of bookbinding service into greater Dublin area from May 2010

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AS PART OF the recently celebrated centenary, Riley Dunn & Wilson in Falkirk, are pleased to announce that we are re-introducing and extending our renowned bookbinding and paper conservation services to Eire, beginning in May 2010 with services into the greater Dublin area.

The Company previously operated very successfully from the 1980s (up until 2004) through Reilly Bookbinders from County Wicklow with a varied customer base including Universities, Colleges, Public Libraries, National, Museums and Art Galleries and professional bodies.

The decision to re-introduce our services has been accelerated due to very positive interest and response from librarians during visits by Charles Dunn – Managing Director and Brian Lynch – Commercial Projects Manager. Many Dublin based library staff have expressed concern to us that since the closure of Reilly Bookbinders in 2007, there is no real competition in the library binding and book repair markets and that they would lend support to Riley Dunn & Wilson if we decided to extend the existing service from Ulster.

We are therefore introducing a collection and delivery service operating on a 4 weekly cycle system beginning with first collections week beginning 25th May.

These services will be provided on a 4–6 weekly turnaround using a mix of our own delivery van and driver and trusted carrier. This new service will work in tandem with our already established customer base in the north of Ireland. As the year progresses, special offers will be made available to participating libraries and it is intended that the services are extended throughout Eire.
